#### A sacred moment

A God who is kindly disposed towards us, who wants to do us good, beyond what we deserve or expect - Luke 2:10, 2:14

The year of Jubilee (Lev 25) which is a picture of the day of salvation

Every 50th year, following the day of atonement



### **Jubilee! Leviticus 25**

A release of people from slavery, by divine decree (v9-10, 41)

All debts discharged

Restoration of possessions and property (v28)

Reconnection with others (v13)

Rest (v11-12)
